March 2024	MOTION 1: That the Mayor and Councillors inform the Combined Precincts as to what methodology and metrics were applied to determine that the community had lost confidence in Cr Fabiano and Cr WyKanak.	<p>The creators of the Change.org petition titled 'Deputy Mayor Ludovico Fabiano Must Resign' was formally submitted to Council which had over 2.5K signatures at the time of submission.</p> <p>Council and Councillors also received numerous phone calls, letters and emails from residents and community groups.</p> <p>Based on the above, which were formally submitted to Council, Council voted and made the decision to amend the term of the Deputy Mayor, and to remove Councillors as members of committees.</p>	Executive Services	Complete
	MOTION 2: The Combined Precincts move that this meeting support the "return & earn" facility be returned to where it was previously at the back of Bondi Beach on Queen Elizabeth Drive.	<p>The Return Vending Machine (RVM) at Bondi Beach was removed following the 7 May 2019 Strategic Planning and Development Committee resolution.</p> <p>The decision followed a report that outlined significant impacts of the large RVM at this location including anti-social behaviour, traffic safety, litter and noise.</p> <p>Since the removal of the RVM at Bondi Beach, Tomra has installed multiple collection points in Bondi Junction, Diamond Bay.</p> <p>Tomra is the Return & Earn deposit scheme operator on behalf of NSW Government.</p> <p>The last six-monthly report available (1 Jan 23 – 30 June 23) shows that nearly 1.8 million containers have been collected in Waverley during that period.</p>	Planning, Sustainability & Compliance	Complete
