Eligibility criteria

- 1. The applicant must reside at the address.
- 2. The MPS permit holder must have an approved TfNSW Mobility Parking Scheme permit.
- 3. The application must be for a vehicle registered to the address.
- 4. The property does not have off-street parking. Consideration will be given if the off-street parking cannot be accessed by the MPS permit holder.
- 5. The parking demand within 50 metres either side and opposite of the property is to be above 85% capacity (this will be assessed by Council officers via a daytime site visit and review of google Street View images).
- 6. There is no other mobility parking space within the vicinity of the property (generally 50 metres within the property)

Forms required by Council

- 1. A copy of both sides of a current mobility parking scheme permits from Transport for NSW (formerly NSW Roads and Maritime Services). A photo or scan is OK.
- 2. A copy of a current vehicle registration certificate with the address matching the residence. The owner of the vehicle can be another person who resides at the same address. A photo or scan is OK.
- Confirmation that the resident does not have access to an off-street parking space (disabled or otherwise). For apartments this could be a letter from the strata manager confirming that the residence does not have an allocated parking spot within the property.

Processing the application

- 1. An application is submitted to Council.
- 2. The application is assessed by a Council officer. The Council officer will contact the applicant and arrange to meet on site if required.
- 3. If the assessment is successful, a report is prepared by a Council officer.
- 4. If approved by Council, officers then arrange for the signs to be installed

Who can access the mobility parking space?

The on-street mobility parking spaces installed by Council for any successful application are available to all eligible MPS permit holders. These on-street mobility parking spaces are not reserved for private use.
