Further work will then be required, including prioritisation against the other 10 locations and funding.</p> <p>This work is ongoing and will take several more months until completion. Once completed, there will still be a need to prioritise further and reconcile with available budgets or future grant funding (which means concrete action may be years away).</p>
