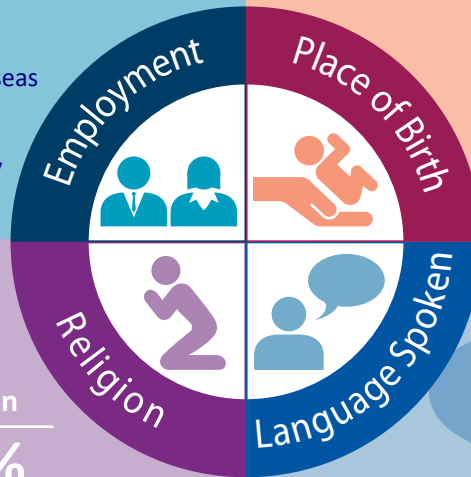


Waverley's Culturally Diverse Community

In 2021, 4% of residents were born overseas, and 21% speak a language other than English with the country of birth and languages spoken being quite different to Greater Sydney.

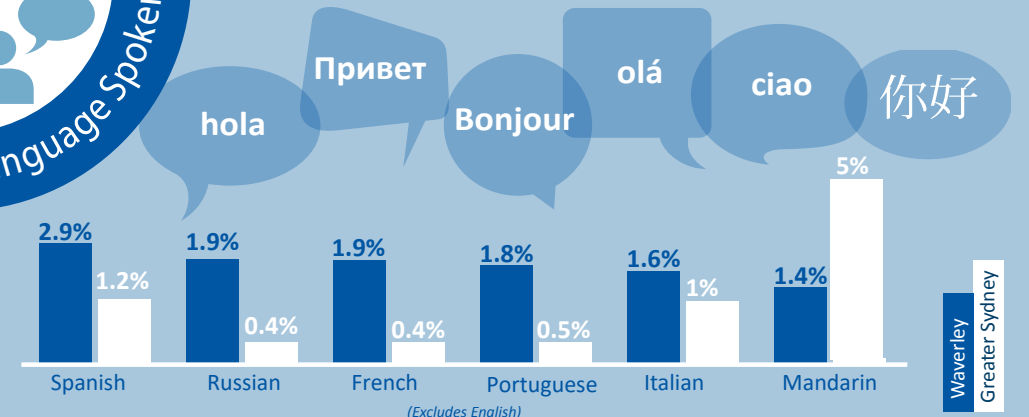
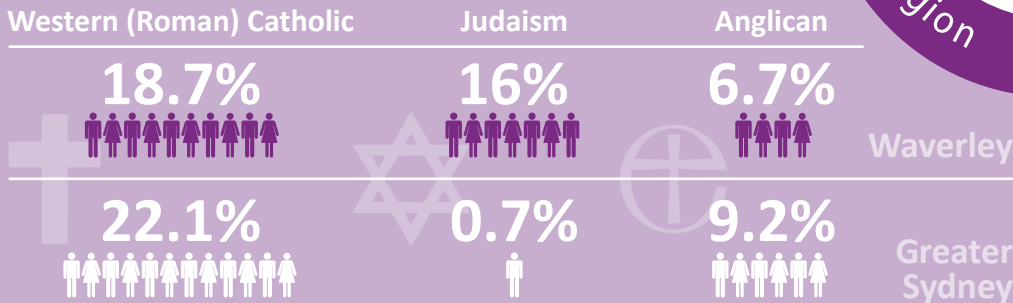
The top 5 industries of employment for Waverley's overseas-born residents are:

- 20.6% Professional, technical and scientific services
 - 10.7% Health care and social assistance
 - 10.2% Financial and insurance services
 - 7.3% Construction
 - 6.5% Retail
- 56% have a Bachelor or Higher Degree
- The median age for overseas residents is 38, slightly higher than the Waverley average of 35.
