





Genoa Apartments: a big fan of \$avings

Participating in Round 3 Waverley Council's Building Futures program, Genoa Apartments on Ebley Street identified a large 13 kilowatt fan running unnecessarily. The energy audit also reviewed energy tariffs and common area energy consumption, to help the Owners Corporation decide how best to reduce costs, and environmental impact.

Switching off the fan reduced the building's total energy usage by 31%, saving \$15,800 per year and 97 tonnes of greenhouse emissions. While changing from a high (standing) gas tariff to a lower rate is also saving an extra \$4,500 every year.

Thanks to the hard work and commitment of the Strata Committee, Strata Manager and Building Manager, the Genoa Apartments is moving towards a brighter future.
