

Bondi Pavilion Restoration and Conservation Project

Construction Update

Bondi Pavilion is being restored as a community and cultural centre for future generations with a major focus on sustainability.

Work continues with the project team on track to completing this important project for the Bondi community on time.

Upcoming works (see map below for detail)

As part of the restoration of Bondi Pavilion, Queen Elizabeth Drive will be temporarily relocated 3-metres to the west of its current location, towards Bondi Pavilion.

What can I expect?

Vehicle and pedestrian routes will be diverted around the works. The existing footpaths will be located at the stair/ramp access points to the north and south of the main beach staircase, and vehicle routes will be changed, as identified in the map below. You may notice increases in construction staff, signage and barriers along Queen Elizabeth Drive.

When will the work take place?

The work to relocate Queen Elizabeth Drive will commence on 7 April 2020, and is expected to take 8 weeks.

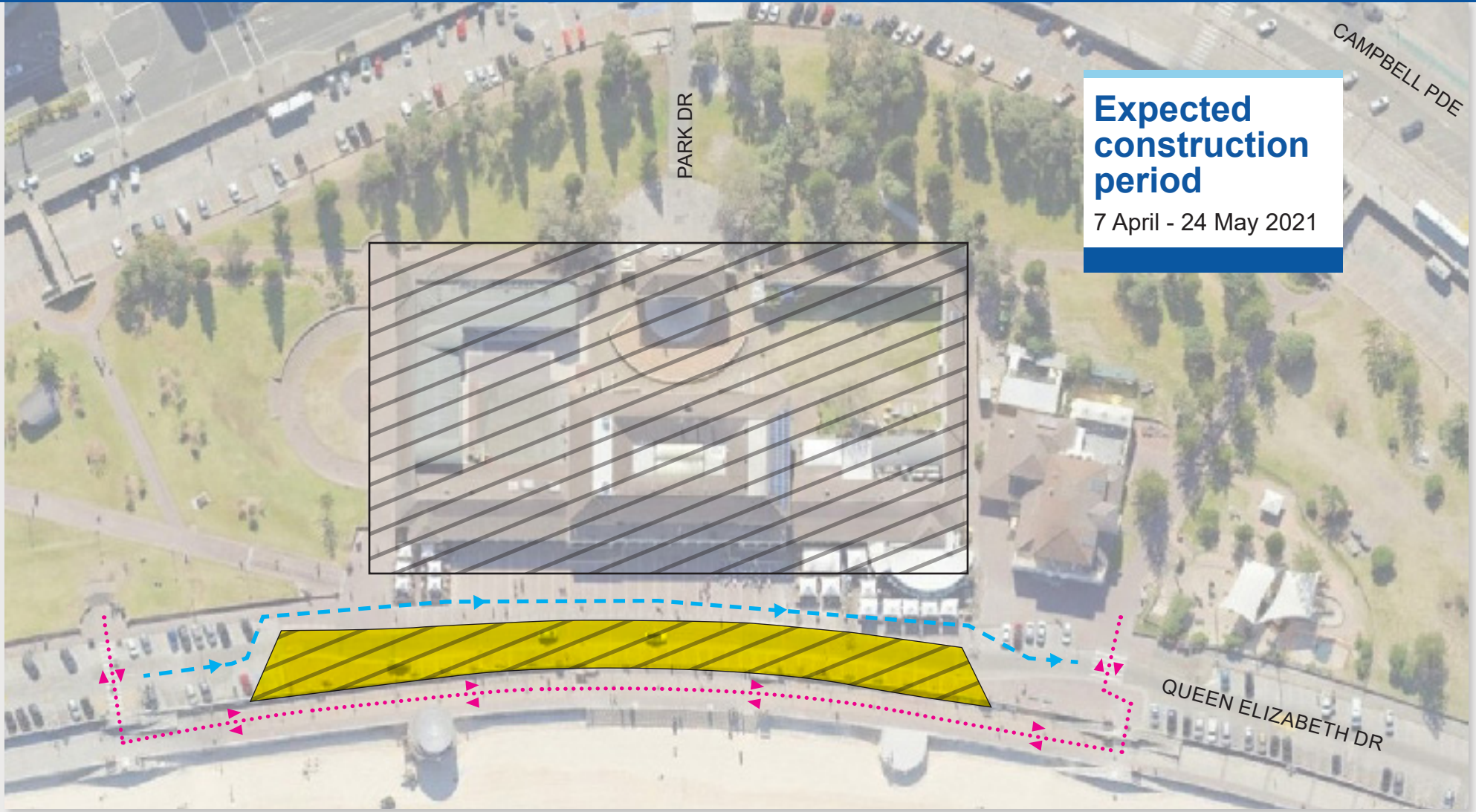
