WILL CONSULTATION TAKE PLACE WITH ALL PRECINCTS INCLUDING BONDI HEIGHTS, BEFORE FINALISATION?	<p>Community engagement / consultation for the intergeneration playground was completed and reported to Council with the main playground in September 2022.</p> <p>The project is in the detailed design phase and will be shovel ready once funding is confirmed.</p> <p>The precinct can review the HYS webpage here: https://haveyoursay.waverley.nsw.gov.au/waverley-park-play-space-upgrade</p> <p>Concept plans with annotations can be viewed here: https://hdp-au-prod-app-waverley-yoursay-files.s3.ap-southeast-2.amazonaws.com/2416/6486/7489/a7125f68da56c3332bdf05e03c545108_Waverley_Park_Concept_Plan.pdf</p> <p>The type of equipment will be from fitness suppliers that target seniors with a range of equipment that targets things such as strength, balance, flexibility, dexterity and cognitive function. Council is required to fulfill our quotation process to procure the equipment. This will not be done until we are confident the project is fully funded, potentially in June 2024.</p> <p>Council has applied for a NSW Govt Community Building Partnership Grant which we expect confirmation in June 2024.</p> <p>The Draft LTFP, currently on public exhibition via our HYS webpage here, includes funding for the second stage of Waverley Park Playground being the picnic area and intergenerational fitness upgrade.</p>	Assets & Operations	In progress

	<p>CONDITION OF THE FOOTPATHS IN KING AND OCEAN STREETS: The meeting was critical of Council’s lack of action in attending to multiple historical requests to renew and make safe the footpaths in King and Ocean Street. Concern for the elderly and infirmed is noted. There was discussion that the matter should be brought to the attention of the news media.</p> <p>QUESTION TO COUNCIL [202404Q2] KING AND OCEAN STREET FOOTPATH REFURBISHMENT – WHEN WILL COUNCIL UNDERTAKE A FULL REFURBISHMENT OF THE FOOT PATHS IN KING AND OCEAN STREETS?</p>	<p>Council has no record of requests regarding King and Ocean Street. Can the Precinct advise when these requests were made?</p> <p>Council will however include these streets in our <i>Active Defect Register</i> for consideration in Council’s 2024/25 cap-Ex program.</p>	Assets & Operations	In progress
	<p>DIFFICULTY FOR MOBILITY PERMIT HOLDERS AT EASTGATE: Mobility permit holders do not move as quickly as able-bodied persons. The one-hour free parking can be inadequate and inequitable, particularly when the special allowances that are afforded to mobility parkers elsewhere in the public domain are considered.</p>	<p>Council experiences significant issues with abuse of mobility permits in the LGA. i.e. Motorist using them without having the holder present, using lost/stolen/defaced/reproduced cards which would make the Precincts suggestion open to great abuse.</p> <p>The conditions of use of a mobility permit state in part:</p> <p>b) The permit must only be displayed when the vehicle is being used to transport the individual to whom the permit was issued. It must not be used to visit or run errands for an eligible person when that person is not</p>	Assets & Operations	Complete

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	<p>REQUEST TO COUNCIL [202404R1] FREE TIME FOR MOBILITY PERMIT HOLDERS AT EASTGATE CARPARK – COUNCIL, PLEASE INVESTIGATE HOW MOBILITY PARKING PERMIT HOLDERS COULD BE GIVEN ADDITIONAL FREE TIME AT EASTGATE CARPARK?</p>	<p>being transported in the vehicle.</p> <p>e) The permit is valid until the date of expiry, unless it is revoked.</p> <p>f) The permit can no longer be used once it expires. It must be renewed and a current permit displayed for any disability parking concessions.</p> <p>h) The permit must not be reproduced, copied, defaced, altered or destroyed.</p> <p>i) The permit is not valid if reproduced, copied, defaced or otherwise altered or where one or more of the details on the permit (e.g. card number or expiry date) are illegible.</p> <p>To check any of the above items would require car park employees to come out of the office and inspect the permit. This would be a potential health and safety risk.</p>
