



Oscar on Hollywood saves big with lighting

With the help of Council’s Building Futures program, the Owners Corporation at Oscar on Hollywood apartment building has retrofitted 317 old light fittings in their carpark, exit signs and emergency batters with energy efficient LEDs.

This is one of a suite of cost-effective energy efficient opportunities identified in an energy audit of the common areas, conducted as part of the program. They are set to save more with carbon monoxide monitoring and VSDs in the carpark.

Thanks to the hard work and commitment of the Strata Committee and Building Manager, the building is moving towards a brighter future.
