Eligibility

- All nominees must live in the Waverley Local Government area, and/or have served the Waverley community.
- Self-nominations will not be accepted. However, community groups may be nominated by a member of that group.
- Nominations are only for voluntary contributions and achievements – apart from the 'Strengthening Community' award, where nominations will be accepted for professionals who have demonstrated outstanding contribution which are beyond their paid role.
- Waverley Community Awards will not be granted posthumously.
- Current serving Waverley Councillors and full time Council staff are not eligible.
- Sitting State and Federal Politicians and current Vice Regal Officers are not eligible.
- Previous award winners are ineligible for nomination in the same category.
- Unsuccessful nominations may be nominated again in subsequent years.
- Nominees for the Youth cateogry must be under 25 years of age at 31 December 2024.
