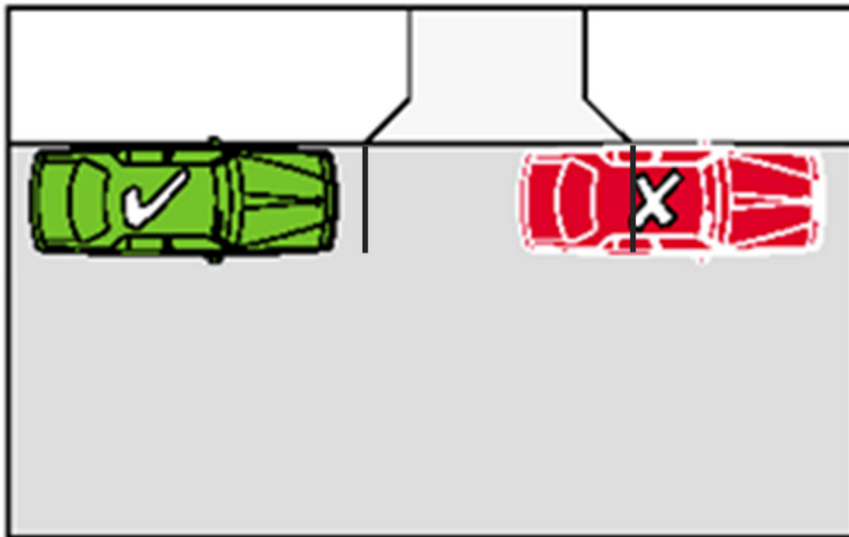
### Application for Driveway Linemarking - A04/0857

Driveway linemarking can assist in reducing the chance that someone blocks the access to a property. Council installs driveway linemarking on behalf of residents and businesses. Other parties do not have authorisation to install driveway linemarking.

New South Wales Road Rule 198 states that a driver must not stop on or across a driveway unless the driver is dropping off, or picking up, passengers. The edge of the driveway is taken as the edge of the wings/splays at the gutter as shown below. Driveway linemarking will only be installed at these locations.



The marking of lines on the road to delineate a driveway is a guide for drivers. If a car is parked partly into the driveway the driver would be infringed under NSW Road Rule 198 (2) – Stop on/across driveway/other access to/from land.

**Note: Should the lines fade you are responsible for the remarking of the new lines. This will entail a new application for Driveway Linemarking to be completed and payment made.**



**Payment** can be made by credit card over the telephone (0.8% surcharge applies to credit card payments – Master, Visa and American Express accepted ). All charges are in accordance with Waverley Council Schedule Fees & Charges for the 2024/2025 financial year.
