And recently the largest and last tree in the centre of the Reserve had died.</li> <li>- children have nothing to play with, as the playground has not been replaced.</li> </ul> <p><b>Noted:</b> Residents have prepared a report with photos, to present to the Council regarding Biddigal Reserve.</p>	Council is investigating this matter and will advise shortly. Many years ago, this was previously available at Bondi Junction near the bus interchange.</p>	The Problem Waste Drop Off Day is a joint event with Waverley, City of Sydney, and Woollahra Councils. The drop off day is held at the depots in Alexandria as there is quite a lot of infrastructure that is needed to safely collect, store and transport the items received. This includes, storage cages, trucks, waste compactors, and forklifts. Traffic control is also required for the day. Following the day, large semi-trailers are brought in to transport the collected items for recycling. Waverley's LGA cannot accommodate this type of facility or event.
