Curlewis St Separated Cycleway	<p>Concept design with alternative options at each of Campbell Parade and Old South Head Road intersections was on Have Your Say, closing on meeting date.</p> <p>To date over 200 responses which are mixed regarding support and options selected. Comment was made that there was some confusion regarding the extent of parking loss, which is intended to be minimal. Comment made that the questions in the HYS survey were ambiguous or misleading</p>

7.1 Casual Bike Parking	<p>The Cycling Strategy Engagement identified a range of site for potential bike parking that will be reviewed.</p> <p>Audit of bike parking required especially in the Oxford St Transit where racks have been lost and Pedestrian Malls in anticipation that racks may be lost.</p>	
7.2 Residential Bike Parking	<p>The issues of residential bike parking was confirmed during the Bicycle Strategy Engagement. There are</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Legality issues with private use of nature strip - Political issues with use of parking lane <p>Options:</p> <p>Racks on concrete slabs on the nature strip – no shelter</p> <p>Guidance to existing strata's for common property</p>	
8 E-Scooters	<p>Discussion on the offer by TfNSW to partner with e-scooter share operators for trial.</p> <p>Issue likely to be lack of ideal routes and the need to restrict to geographic. Potential practical routes included Bondi Junction to UNSW; Bondi Basin; Bondi Junction; connecting to bus network. Route between Bondi Basin and Bondi Junction not ideal.</p> <p>Participation in trial could build more allies to grow the bike network.</p>
