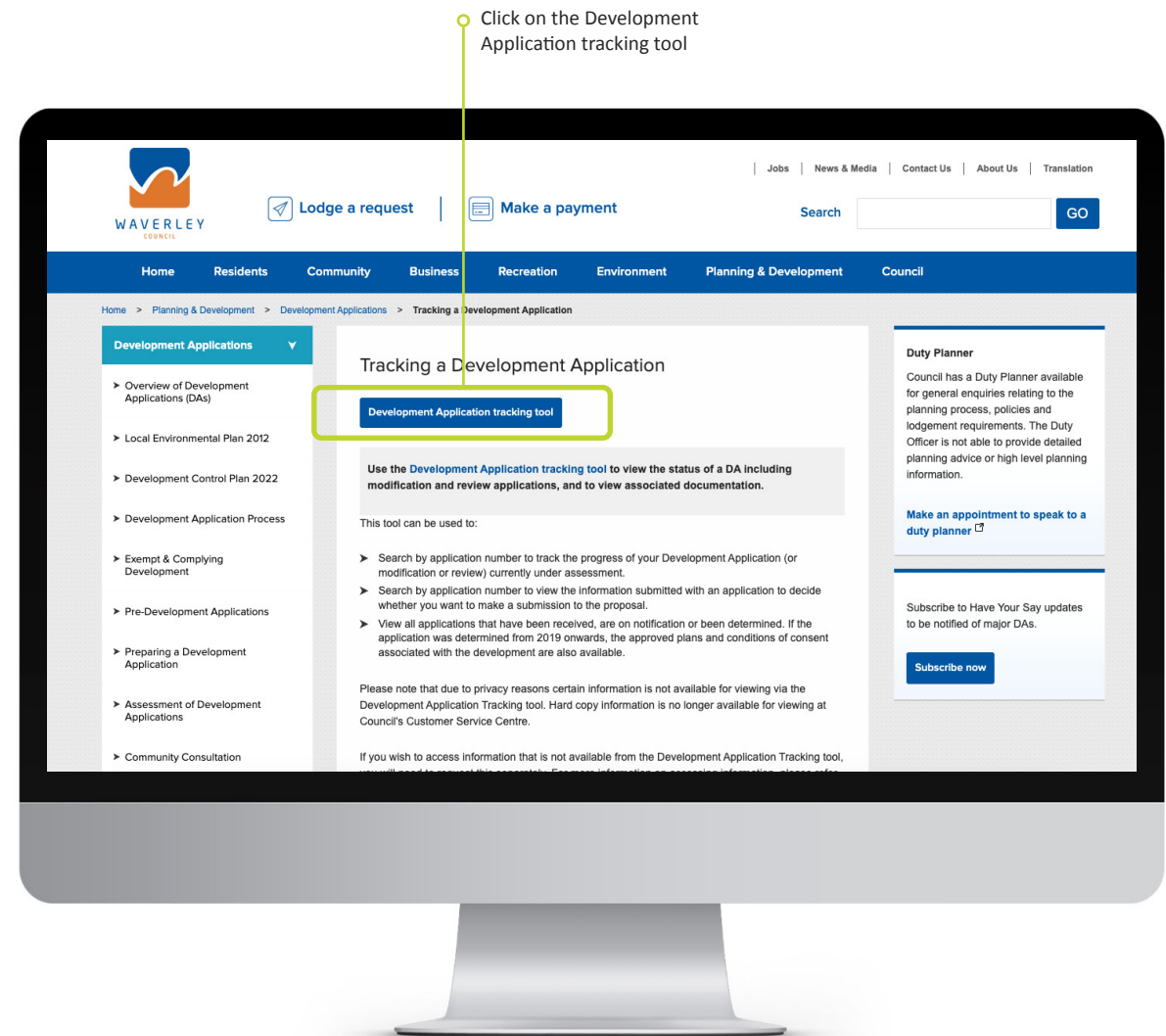


How to use Waverley Council's DA tracker

Step 1.

If you want to see the plans for what someone wants to build, you can check them out on [Waverley Council's website](#).

Once you have arrived on this page, click on the Development Application tracking tool.

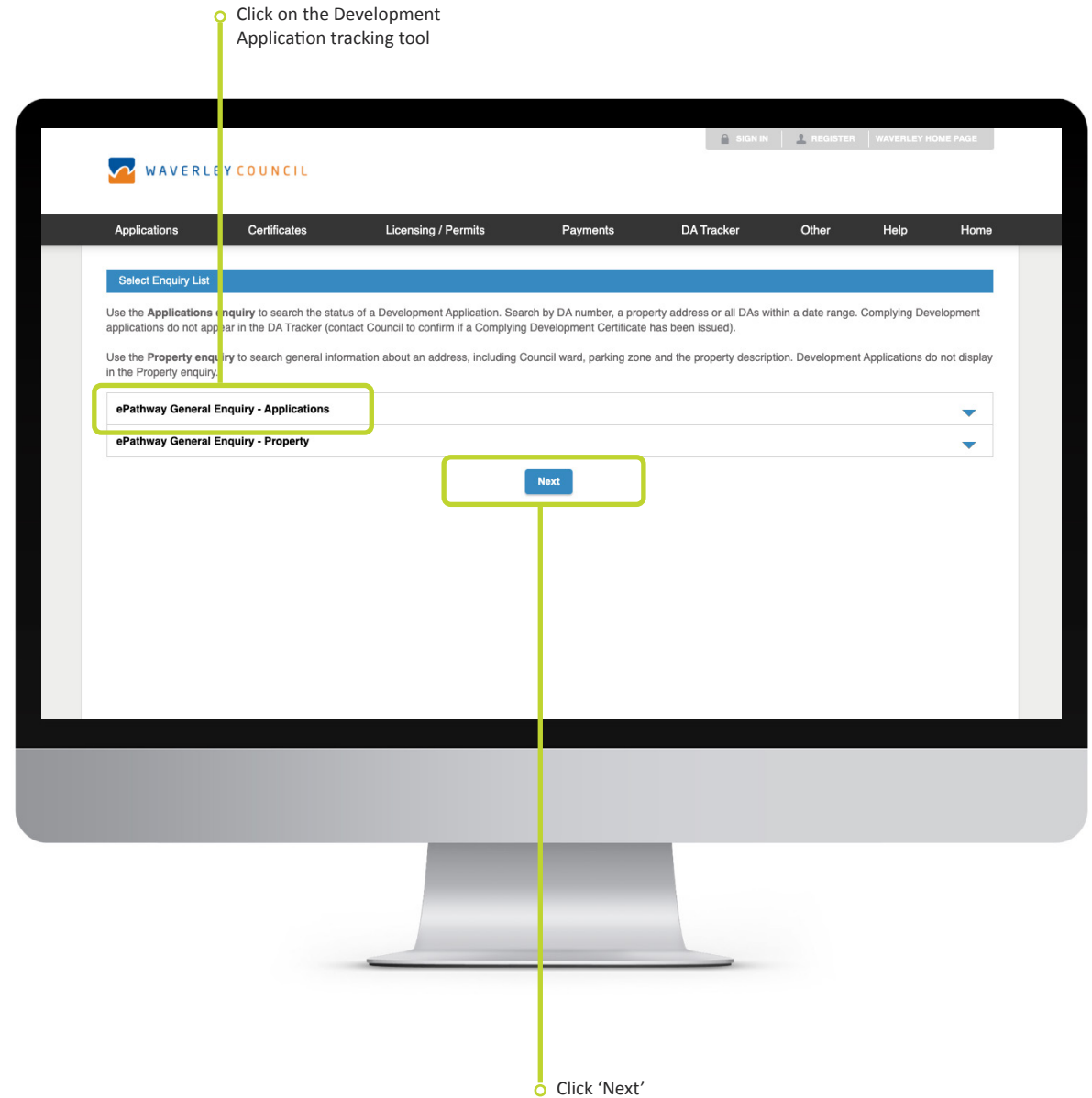


Step 2.

Waverley Council's Development Application tracking tool looks like this.

You don't need to sign in or register.

Click on ePathway General Enquiry – Applications.



Step 3.

There are a few ways to search for a development application.

To widen your search, select “Applications received list” and then click “Next”.

Select Enquiry List

Use the **Applications enquiry** to search the status of a Development Application. Search by DA number, a property address or all DAs within a date range. Complying Development applications do not appear in the DA Tracker (contact Council to confirm if a Complying Development Certificate has been issued).

Use the **Property enquiry** to search general information about an address, including Council ward, parking zone and the property description. Development Applications do not display in the Property enquiry.

ePathway General Enquiry - Applications

Description	Instructions
<input checked="" type="radio"/> Applications received list	All applications received by Waverley Council. This list includes applications that are on notification, under assessment and determined.
<input type="radio"/> Applications determined list	All applications that have been determined by Waverley Council. These applications are no longer under assessment.
<input type="radio"/> Applications on notification list	All applications currently under assessment and on notification.

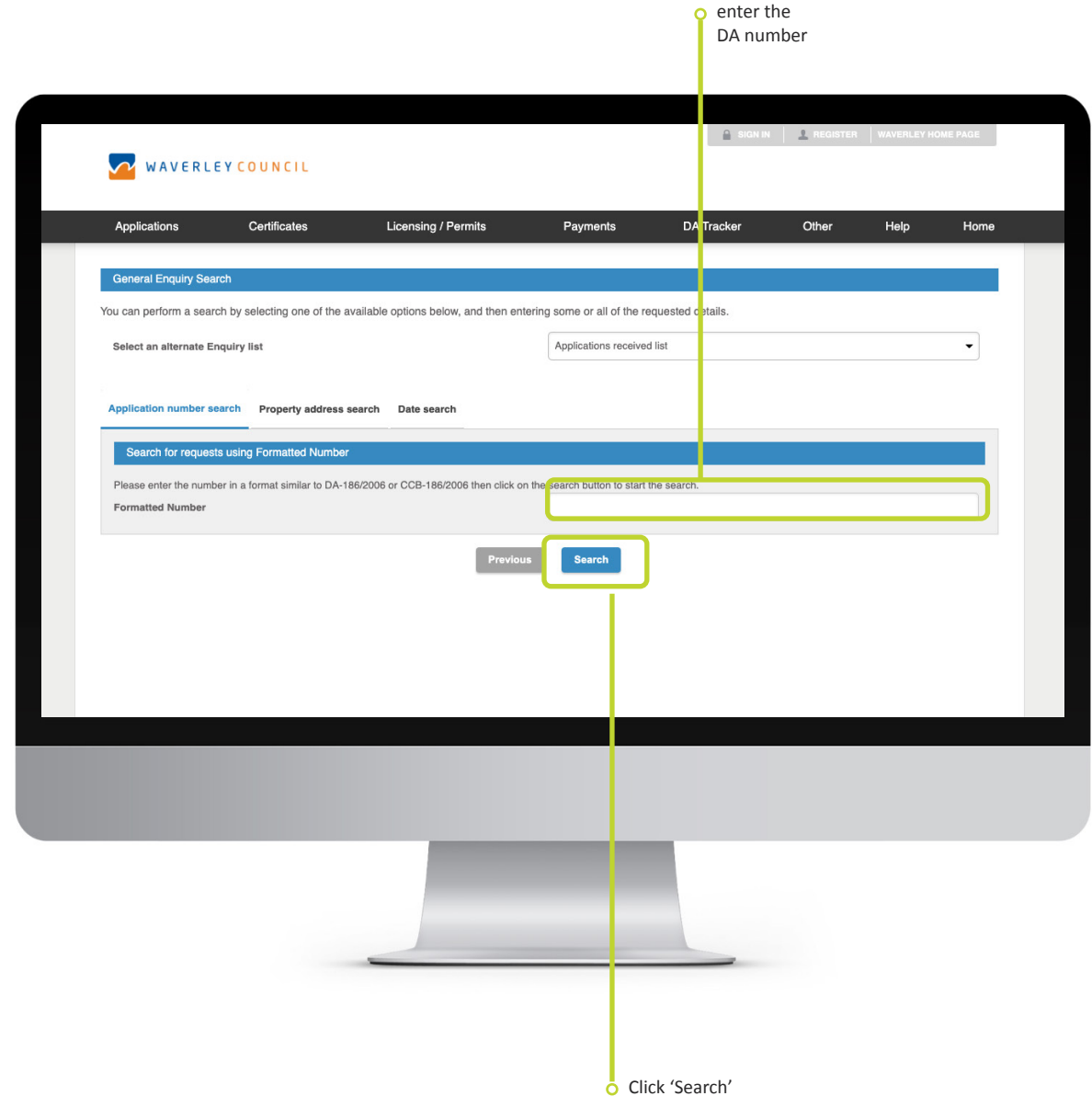
Click 'Next'

Step 4.

You can search for a DA with an application number or with a property address or you can search using a date. To search for building works using the application number, enter the DA number, the format should be similar to DA-XXX/20XX and then click **“Search”**. *(If you don't have a DA number, go to step 5.)*

After you have clicked “search”, you can find the building plans, under the “Documents” heading.

Note: If you enter the application number incorrectly or its not in the above format, an error will pop up stating *“There were no results returned for the selected enquiry list”*. To start again, click DA Tracker and go back to Step 2.



Step 5.

If you would like to search for a DA using a property address, click **“Property address search”** then enter the “Street Number”, “Street Name”, “Street Type” and “Suburb” and click **“Search”**.

Note: If you enter the property address incorrectly, an error will pop up stating *“There were no results returned for the selected enquiry list”*. To start again, click DA Tracker and go back to Step 2.

After you have clicked “search”, you can find the building plans, under the “Documents” heading.

Some property addresses will have more than one development application lodged. If you scroll to the bottom of the page, you will locate the most recently lodged development application for that property address.
